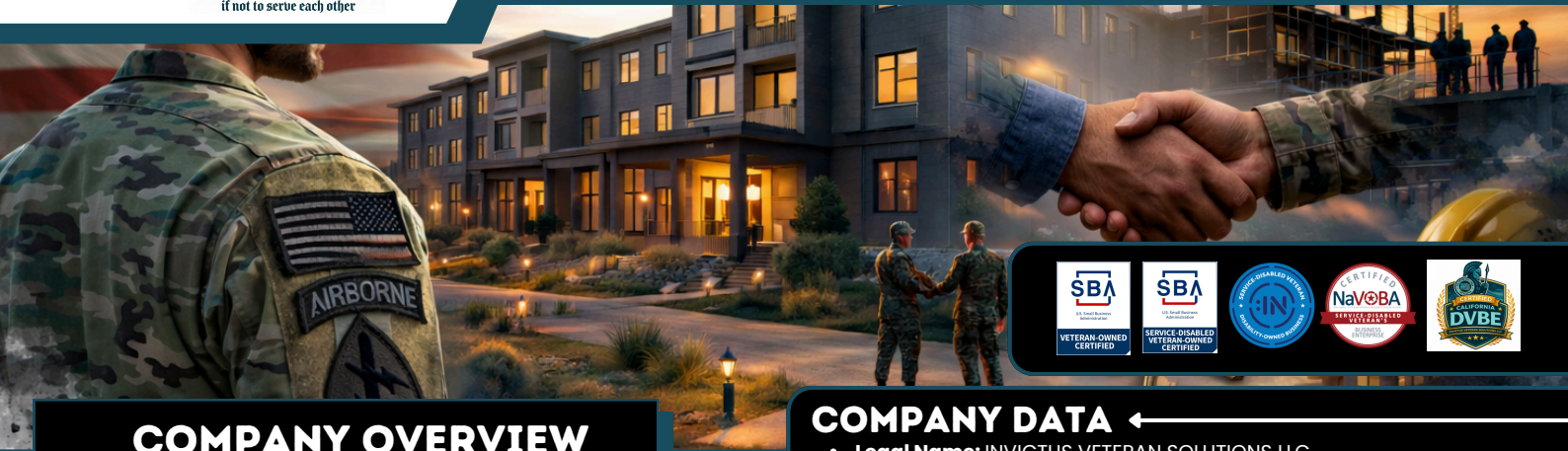


CAPABILITY STATEMENT



COMPANY OVERVIEW

INVICTUS VETERAN SOLUTIONS LLC is a Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business (SDVOSB) based in Porter Ranch, California, providing Veteran Supportive-Housing Consulting, Mission-Driven Construction, Facilities Maintenance and Operations Support, Veteran Peer Support, Veteran Workforce Development, and Partnership Opportunities to address the needs within the veteran community. Led by former U.S. Army Special Operations veteran Ren H. Ross, who has supported the development of over 800 veteran housing units across Los Angeles and Orange County, with experience in Low-income housing funding opportunities like Section 8, HUD-VASH, HCD, VHHP, and LIHTC programs. INVICTUS works with federal and state government agencies, developers, and service providers to deliver housing solutions with the essential wrap around supportive services for long-term veteran stability and recovery. Invictus will prioritize veteran employment and partnerships with veteran-owned subcontractors to address the needs within our veteran community, and ensure our nations heroes get career advancement opportunities.
